1. CALL TO ORDER & PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Chairman Wood called the Public Works/Public Safety Committee to order on Tuesday, January 14, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. at the City Hall Annex Chambers, with the Pledge of Allegiance immediately following.

2. ROLL CALL:

Motion by Committee member Bell, seconded by Committee member Weidenhamer to change the order of the day by adding the Stormwater/Flood Plain Public Comments to the agenda passed with a vote of 4-0.

3. NOMINATION OF CHAIRMAN & VICE CHAIRMAN

➤ **Chairman**

Motion by Committee member Weidenhamer, seconded by Committee member Bell to nominate Jim Wood as Chairman passed 4-0.

➤ **Vice Chairman**

Motion by Chairman Wood, seconded by Committee member Bell to nominate John Green as Vice Chairman passed 4-0.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

➤ **October 8, 2024**

Motion to approve the minutes of October 8, 2024, meeting was made by Committee member Bell with Committee member Weidenhamer providing the second. The motion passed 4-0.

5. NEW BUSINESS:

➤ **Committee Orientation – Joe Bodi Deputy Public Works Director**

Mr. Bodi provided an overview of the key points in the committee handbook, outlining the responsibilities of committee members. He noted that he would prefer to wait until the committee is fully seated before formally discussing and assigning specific areas of the city to each member. However, since all present members have previously served on the committee, they may continue overseeing their previously assigned areas in the meantime.

Chairman Wood highlighted several sections of the handbook that require updates. Both staff and committee members engaged in a discussion regarding these necessary revisions. Mr. Bodi also outlined the timeline he must follow to finalize and distribute the agenda to both the committee and the public. He further explained the deadline for determining whether to cancel a meeting if there are no agenda items requiring discussion.

Additionally, there was a brief discussion on the upcoming February Visioning Session and the 2026 Budget Forecast.

6. CONTINUING BUSINESS:

➤ **Stormwater/Floodplain Public Comments**

Chairman Wood opened the floor for public comments on this item. With no one coming forward, he closed the public discussion on the topic.

7. MEMBER DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Committee Member Green – Expressed his desire to continue working on transportation improvements.

Committee Member Weidenhamer – Emphasized the need for the development of an electric bicycle policy.

Committee Member Bell – Inquired about the status of pedestrian improvements at the crosswalk located at Airport Road and Commons Blvd. In response, Mr. Bodi stated that these improvements are still in the design phase.

Committee Member Bell also raised concerns about the traffic light at Sandpiper Cove, noting that during periods of high winds, the light swings significantly. She asked whether there are any future plans to install it on a mast arm. Mr. Bodi explained that such an installation would be very costly and that a portion of the traffic light is privately owned by Sandpiper Cove and maintained by Okaloosa County.

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8. ADJOURNMENT:

Having no further business at this time, the meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
